

POLICY OF DIGVIJAYA AND DHARMAVIJAYA

In North India Samudragupta followed the policy of Digvijaya which means defeating the enemy and annexing the kingdom

In South India Samudragupta followed the Policy of Dharmavijaya (Grahana-Moksha –Anugraha) which means defeating the enemy and getting authority over the kingdom, setting him free and allowing them to rule the kingdom under his suzerainty
